- 17. Each school affiliated with the Board shall frame Service Rules for its employees which will be as per Education Act of the state/U.T., if the Act makes adoption of the same obligatory, otherwise as per Service Rules given in Affiliation Bye Laws Further, Service contract will be entered with each employee as per the provisions in the Education Act of the state/ U.T., or as given in Appendix III, if not obligatory as per the State Education Act.
